(Fall 2023-ongoing)





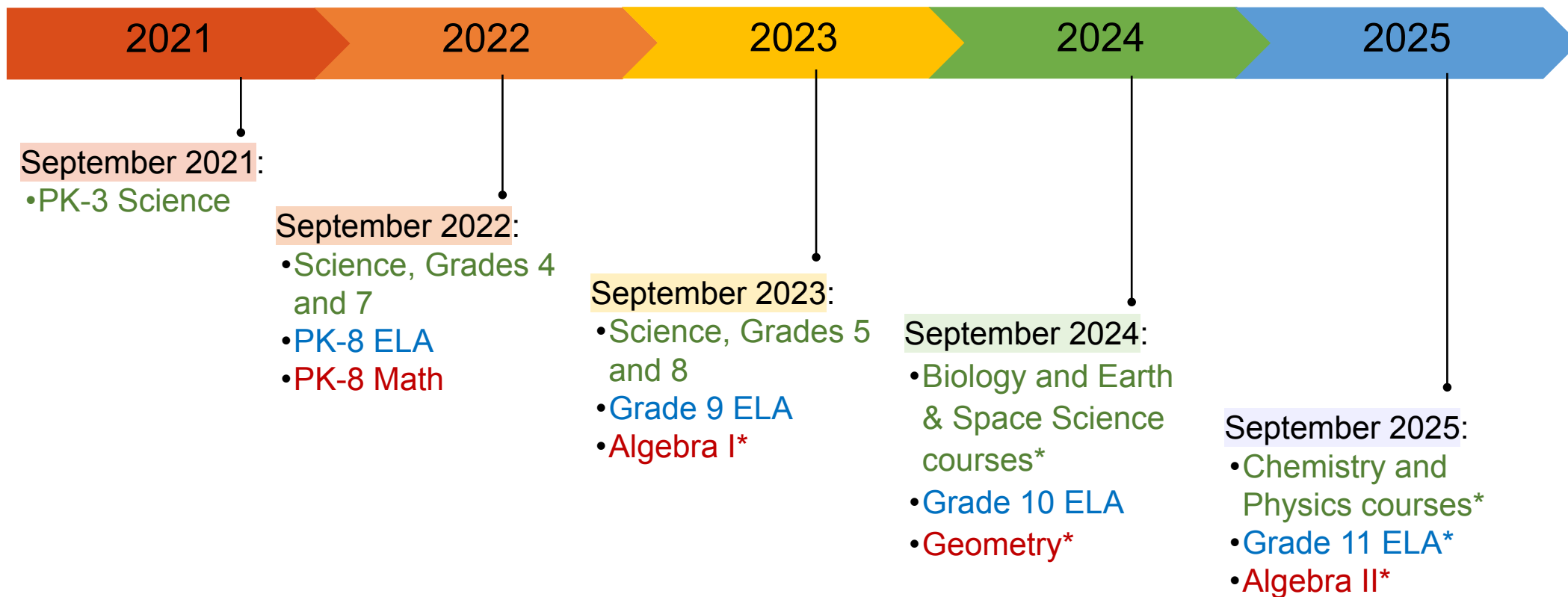
# ELA, Math, Science Standards

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- English Language Arts Learning Standards
  - Grades PK-8 transition to NGLS
  - Spring 2023: First Administration of GR3-8 ELA test aligned to NGLS
- Mathematics Learning Standards
  - Grades 3-8 transition to NGLS (PK-2 began 2019-20)
  - Spring 2023: First Administration of GR3-8 ELA test aligned to NGLS
- Science Learning Standards
  - Grades 4 and 7 new standards (Pk-3 and 6 began 2019-20)
  - Spring 2023: No Grade 4 Science Test, these students will take Grade 5 Science Test in Spring 2024. Last administration of Grade 8 science test aligned to 1996 Standards.

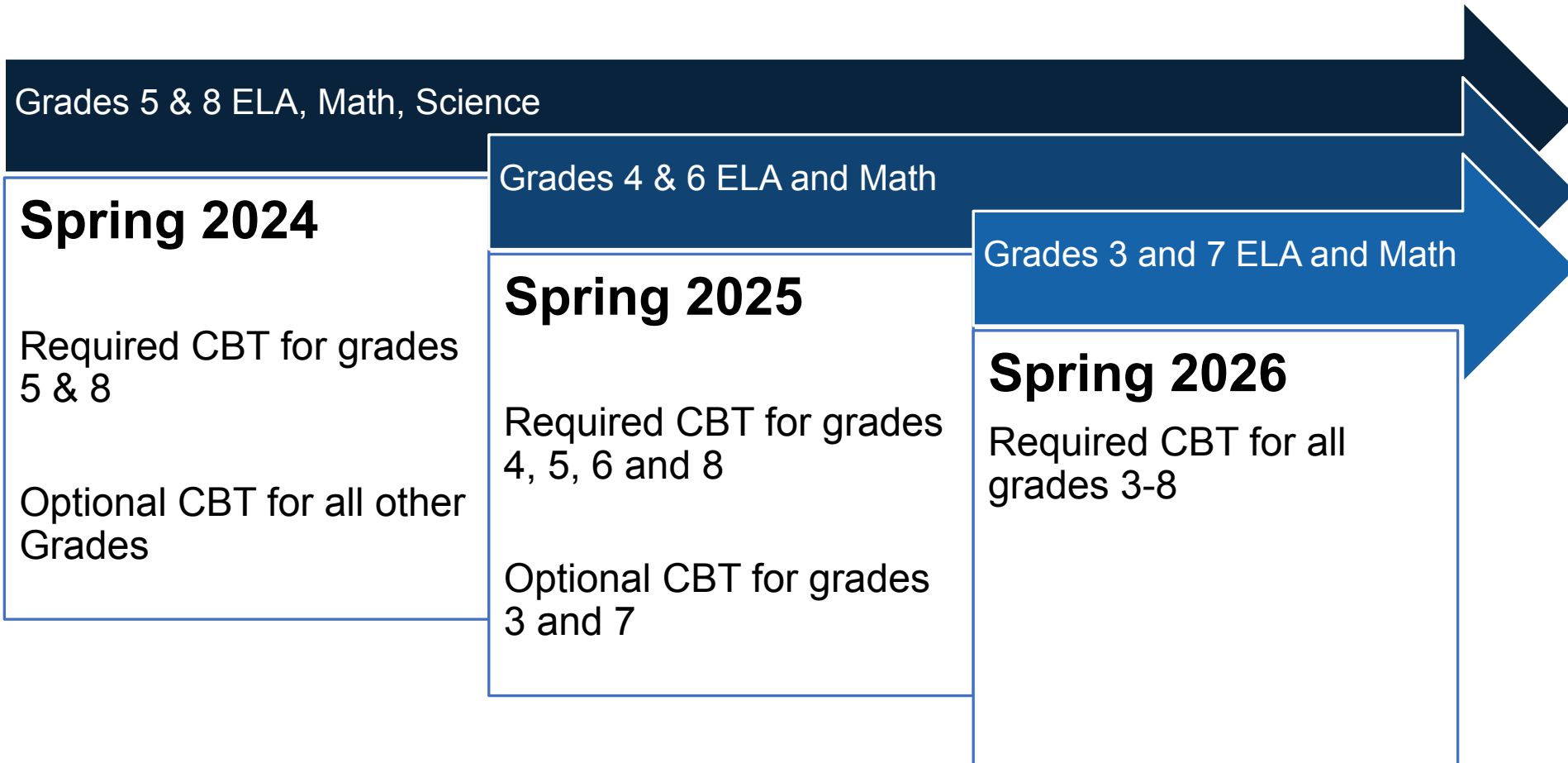
# Implementation Timelines

\* Credit-bearing courses aligned to Regents Exams

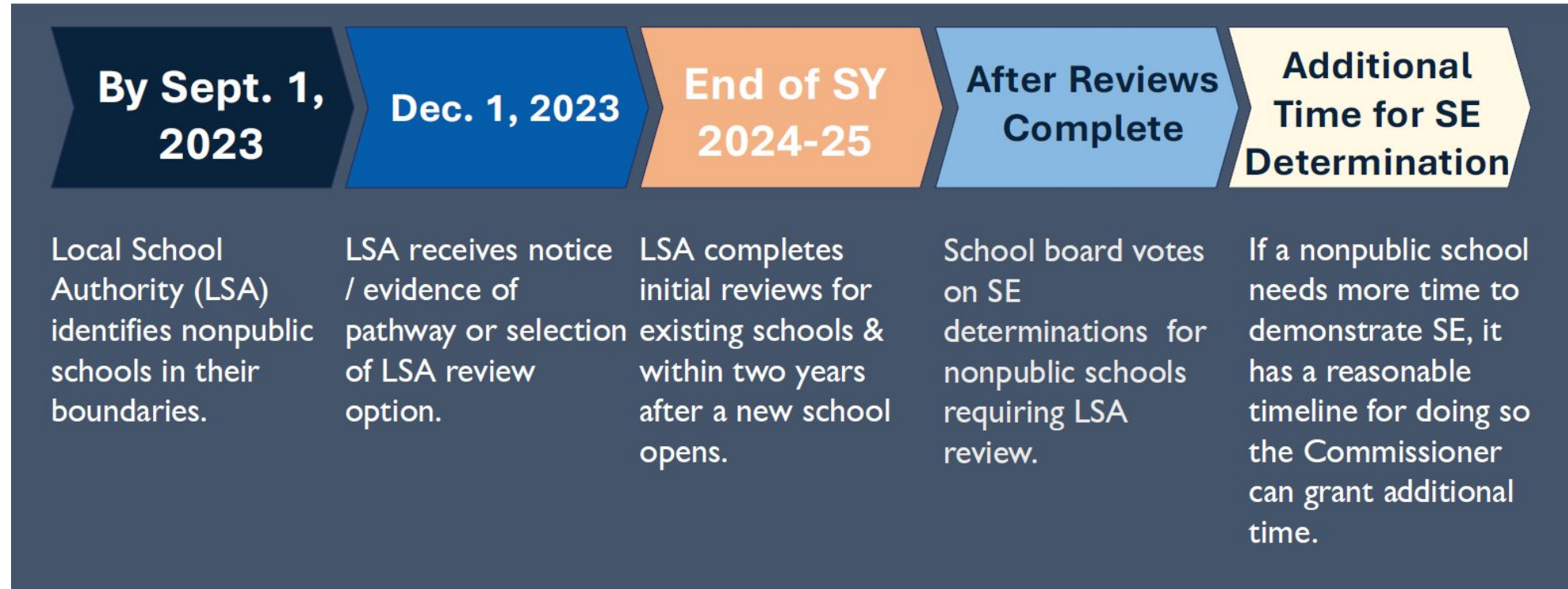
